

HAVE FUN THIS HALLOWEEN DRESS CHILDREN SAFELY

Help children practice **STOP**, hands over their face, **DROP & ROLL** to extinguish flames

Avoid billowing fabrics, layers & trailing fabric.
Choose well-fitting costumes in thicker material

Look for **“FLAME RESISTANT”** labels on costumes,
less likely to ignite & extinguish more quickly

Lantern's, candles, tea-lights in pumpkins &
sparklers are all lethal to children.
Try using torches or glow sticks instead

Outerwear, costumes & props can be trimmed with
visible reflective tape so children can be seen

Warning labels on costumes and props are
important advice to **READ BEFORE YOU BUY**

Ensure you buy costumes from reputable sources,
manufactured to a high safety standard.

Eye openings in masks should be large for your
child to see clearly & loose to remove quickly.
